Sales publications of the Bureau of Mines can be obtained from the Superintendent of Documents, United States Government Printing Office, Washington 25, D.C., to whom orders should be sent direct. Remittances for such publications may be by money order, check, or cash. Stamps are not accepted. For convenience in remitting, coupons having a face value of 5 cents each are sold by the Superintendent of Documents in sheets of 20 for \$1.

However, because of the limited editions, only one copy of any free publication generally can be sent to the person applying, and only a few different publications to any one applicant.
